

## European Water Tech Week Leeuwarden 2018

The water sector will be introduced with the European Water Tech Week Leeuwarden (EWTW 2018) for the first time in 2018. The water technology sector is increasingly organized worldwide in hubs. These hubs are interconnected during the European Water Tech Week Leeuwarden. Leeuwarden is United Nations Innovating City for water technology and the sector meets here in the innovative climate of the Water Campus during EWTW 2018.

Leaders in the field of innovation, technology and policy of companies, universities and governments meet and inspire each other during a number of events, from **24 to 27 September 2018**, in Stadsschouwburg De Harmonie and the WTC Leeuwarden. The Wetsus Congress, the WaterLink conference of WaterAlliance and an innovation fair will be part of the program. Other parts will be announced later. Around these events a unique cultural program is put together, in which water is central. This is linked to the festivities in the context of Leeuwarden, Cultural Capital of Europe 2018.

During EWTW 2018, the central question will be how multidisciplinary cooperation can contribute to the solutions for the global water problem. The agenda includes topics such as water scarcity, water pollution, and water & health. The contribution of the water sector to the circular economy is also discussed. The vision on these topics from science, business and politics will be shared by key-note speakers from all over the world. In interactive sessions and on the exhibition floor, these topics will be further explored and the opportunities for innovation and business will be discussed.

The EWTW 2018 is particularly interesting for teachers of chemistry, physics and biology, but everyone is welcome, of course.
